Rules & Regulations of the Institute

Aakar School of Nursing prepares its trainees to become exemplary citizens by adhering to code of ethics and professional conduct at all times in fulfilling personal and professional obligations.

- Every student admitted to the B.Sc. / GNM / ANM course shall have to follow rules and regulations of the institute.
- All decisions taken by the management are final.
- Students must assemble in the college campus for the prayer sharp at prescribed time every day. Students are required to be regular and punctual for the class. Students are expected to be in the class at least 5 minutes before the commencement of the period.
- Students should maintain perfect order and strict silence inside the lecture hall.
- Movement outside the class room in between lectures should be minimum and for valid reasons only.
- Loitering around the corridors during classes and attending other classes are not allowed.
- Students should maintain silence in the class, library, reading room and in the corridors.
- Students should make every effort to take care of the college and hospital property and help in maintaining the same. They should not write on the black board, scribble on tables, chairs, walls etc.
- Students are not allowed to come directly to the Principal office without permission of the class coordinator, until there is any emergency.
- If the students have any problem, they should inform the class representative and the class representative will intimate it to the class coordinators. If the problem is not solved at the class coordinator's level, then the class students should by-pass the above mentioned channels. Exceptions are allowed only if the problem is utmost urgent/serious.
- A student nurse is not allowed to receive gift or gratuity of any sort at any time from the patients of the hospital or their relatives.
- Students are required to maintain ethical and professional standards in behavior both inside and outside the college, hospital, hostel and community premises.
- Each student is responsible for the proper handling and safe custody of any apparatus or equipment that she may be using in different nursing labs. Misuse or negligence will result in replacement of the particular item by the candidate. Any willful damage done to the property of the college or hospital will be treated as breach of discipline.
- Students are not allowed to paste notices within the institutions without prior written permission from the Office of the Principal.
- Students are forbidden to communicate with any person outside the authority without permission from the Office of the Principal.
- Any student who damages the reputation of the institute in any way is liable to be expelled. If
 any student discontinues the course, she shall clear all dues before leaving the college. If she
 fails to pay, her original certificates will be retained and will be returned once the dues are
 cleared by the student.
- Violating the rules of institute / hostel will be dealt with seriously by the college authorities and if necessary dismissal from the college may be considered depending upon the seriousness of the violation
- The institute provides paid transport facilities for students field work but whenever this is not feasible, the student will have to use public transport at her own expenses.
- Rules are subject to change from time to time.



Rules & Regulations of the Hostel

- Rooms should be kept clean and tidy. Students are fully responsible for any loss / damage of furniture / fixture allotted to them and fines will be imposed accordingly.
- Proper locks should be used for cupboards and boxes. Jewellery and expensive items are not permitted in the rooms and the school authority shall not be responsible for any theft / loss or damage of students personal belongings in any manner whatsoever.
- Wastage of water and electricity will lead to strong disciplinary action.
- Students should come to the Hostel Canteen in proper attire.
- In case of sickness. students should report to the Principal / Warden.
- No electrical cooking or heating appliances will be allowed in hostel MOM.
- Visitors are not allowed to go in the students room.
- In case of gross misconduct, student may be expelled from the Nursing school. In such case, fees paid shall not be refunded.
- Management is fully autorized to effect any change in rules and regulations at anytime.
- Hostel rules as declared by the management will be binding on the hostel residents from the date and time of allotment of the hostel seat.
- Ragging is strictly prohibited and will result in immediate expulsion of the student from the institute.

ANTI RAGGING

Ragging in any form is banned inside and outside the campus of Aakar School of Nursing. Strict action is taken against persons flouting this rule; no leniency is shown. Suspension and/or withdrawal from the hostel/institute is the first action against the offender. The Supreme Court of India has also defined ragging as a criminal offense.

Any conduct by a student, whether by words spoken or written or by an act which includes physical abuse, lewd acts, teasing, rough or rude treatment, indulging in rowdy, undisciplined and obscene activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, undue hardship, physical or psychological harm or mental trauma or raise apprehension or fear in a fresher /junior student or other students or forcing a student to do any act which such a student is not willing to do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment or danger to a student's life or adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.
